

The Grant District 110 Educational Foundation in Fairview Heights, IL is accepting applications for its annual scholarships. The Foundation will offer two \$1000 scholarships to students who are graduates of Grant District 110.

To be considered, high school and college freshmen applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a graduate of Grant School District 110.
2. Plan to advance their education by attending an accredited university, college, junior college or vocational school. Applications for admission must have been submitted for the 2011 fall semester or later.
3. Submit a completed application, including an essay explaining career goals, listing school preference and providing reasons the candidate should be awarded the scholarship. The essay should be between 300 - 500 words.
4. High school seniors and college freshmen, please provide two letters of recommendation: one from a person not related to you, the other from a member of their respective school staff, and a seventh semester high school transcript. (It may be a copy).

All other applicants must meet the criteria in 1,2 and 3 above and the following: Provide two letters of recommendation, one letter from an employer or person not related to you and the other from a former/present member of the academic community.
